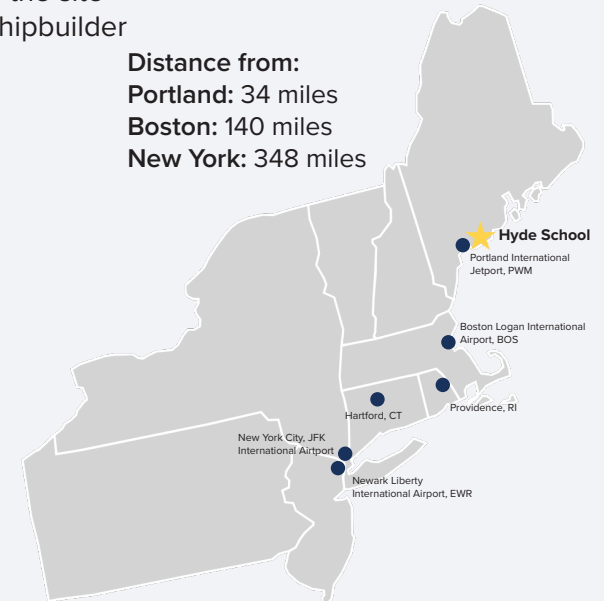


Our campus is situated on the site of the 145-acre estate of shipbuilder John S. Hyde.
