The Bement School aims to enroll a globally and locally diverse group of students. Our English Language Learning program helps students for whom English is not a native language succeed in our academic program. The ELL program at Bement consists of specialized English language learning class sections that provide support in reading, writing, and speaking English, as well as support for achieving success in other academic disciplines.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNING PLACEMENT

To be admitted to Bement, a student must have the ability to speak, read, understand, and write English well enough to participate in all academic areas without extensive help. Once enrolled, students complete an online proficiency test (iTEP). These results, along with an assessment of the student's school performance and an interview, help determine placement in ELL. English language learners require at least one year and often up to two years of English language study at Bement.

CLASS CONTENT

The ELL curriculum gives students daily opportunities to refine their reading, writing, speaking, and listening abilities. Students learn new vocabulary, participate in literature-discussion circles, make research presentations, and write essays related to their classroom texts. Because of the small size of their ELL classes, students receive instruction according to their levels of English proficiency. This personalized instruction allows students to participate fully in their other academic classes, in which they learn among the general student population.

READINESS FACTORS

The Bement School faculty believe that ELL students are best prepared for our rigorous general English curriculum when they can demonstrate the following skills:

- Writing independently and in a manner that is plainly understood by teachers and peers
- Demonstrating comprehension of grade-level reading texts
- Speaking clearly and conveying ideas effectively in classroom conversations and presentations
- Easily understanding spoken language during classroom discussions
