COLLEGE ADVISING

Finding a great university is about finding the one that's right for you. We guide our students on a personal journey to engage with their coursework and their life beyond the classroom. As an extension of this personalized approach, our college advising team facilitates the thoughtful selection, application, and admission to the best-fitting university for your child. Our students are prepared for college academics. At NBPS, our prestigious academic program allows students to demonstrate strengths in specific academic areas, as well as an impressive breadth of knowledge across a wide range of college-level competencies.

Our college advising is customized for each child. Regularly scheduled meetings with the students as well as their parents serves to initiate the right conversation with critically important questions that help determine the colleges that are right for each student. College Advising hosts informational meetings for parents throughout the school year, and offers students the opportunity to meet college admission representatives on our campus.





OUR HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM

North Broward Preparatory High School is a top, private IB high school in Florida. From 9th through 12th grade, your child will rigorously prepare for college through challenging academics, honor classes, AP and IB classes, and enrichment programs. Students enjoy the academically stimulating environment where they can explore their interests, learn to collaborate, think critically, and prepare for college and beyond.

North Broward Prep's standout academic programs and robust high school curriculum provide an unmatched educational experience, tailored to each student's interests.

Some of our other distinguishing features include:

- Choosing from over 180 courses, 34 honors courses, 14 advanced placement courses, and 25 International Baccalaureate courses
- Participating in an offering from 14 competitive, intramural, and developmental sports programs
- Social and emotional support provided through our N.E.S.T. (nurturing, empathetic, support team) program to foster good relationships with our students and our NEST counselor
- A global education experience the opportunity to attend a school with fellow students from over 50 countries
- Students are taught by highly trained teachers from around the world

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

The AP program is a rigorous nationally defined curricula that challenges students with college level curriculum designed to reflect introductory courses at a college or university. The program was created by the College Board (the same organization that authors the SAT) in order to advance student opportunities in high school. The Advanced Placement Program offers high school students the equivalent of a one-semester university-level course. AP teachers support students in learning environments that allows them to tackle curriculum ahead of their years.



INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)

North Broward Preparatory School has been an accredited IB World School since 2008. The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme is one of the highest-rated academic programs in the world and prepares students for success in any international college or university. It's designed to develop a universal two-year high school curriculum with appropriate challenges to address the intellectual, social, emotional, and physical well-being of students.
