

AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS: NATIONAL MERIT FINALISTS

Class of 2023 has had the largest group of National Merit Finalists with eleven students being selected. Of the 1.5 million entrants, some 50,000 with the highest PSAT/ NMSQT[®] Selection Index scores (calculated by doubling the sum of the Reading, Writing and Language, and Math Test scores) qualify for recognition in the National Merit Scholarship Program. In September, these high scorers are notified through their schools that they have qualified as either Commended Students or Semifinalists, with more than 16,000 students, or approximately one-third of the 50,000 being informed that they have qualified as Semifinalists.

To ensure that academically talented young people from all parts of the United States are included in this talent pool, Semifinalists are designated on a staterepresentational basis. Semifinalists are the highest scoring entrants in each state. To be considered for a National Merit Scholarship, Semifinalists must advance to Finalist standing in the competition by meeting high academic standards and all other requirements explained in the information provided to each Semifinalist. In February, over 15,000 Semifinalists are notified that they have advanced to Finalist standing. High school Principals are also notified and provided with a Certificate of Merit to present to each Finalist.


