



小学期制 (THE MODULE SYSTEM)

威斯顿剑桥中学独特的小学期制,将学年分为六个六周的小学期。每一个小学期间,同学们选取三门学术主课,加上一门艺术、体育方面的辅课。每门主课在六周期间,天天上课,每堂课时为90分钟。每位学生都可依据自己的兴趣与学术规划,排出自己的课表。此小学期制现已成为许多美国私立学校的参考范例。

THE MOD SYSTEM

The CSW calendar year is divided into six, six-week modules in a framework we know as the Mod System. During each mod, students take three blocks of academic classes that meet every day for 90 minutes. No two student schedules are the same!

PACE: PROMOTING AWARENESS & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Through the PACE program, we dedicate time for experiential classes meant to help students develop self-awareness, social consciousness, healthy living habits, life skills, and leadership that will serve them into adulthood.

LOCATION, LOCATION, LOCATION!

While CSW boasts a beautifully serene and safe campus nestled in the woods of Weston, MA, we're also just 12 miles from Cambridge and Boston.

SOCIAL JUSTICE EMPHASIS

Social justice is a fundamental component of the CSW curriculum,. Students regularly explore the histories of non-western cultures or minority groups; study the origins, causes, and effects of discrimination and prejudice; and examine models of social change with the goal of advancing human rights.

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

CSW students connect with course content in personally meaningful ways through lively debate, hands-on experiences, laboratories, studios, rehearsals, service-based learning, collaborative projects and off-campus research.
