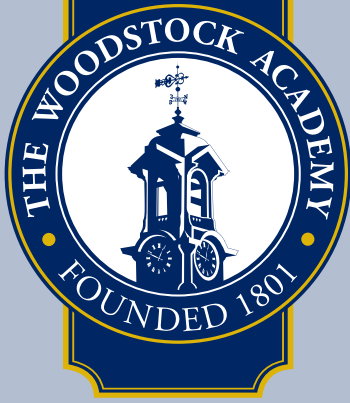


THE WOODSTOCK ACADEMY

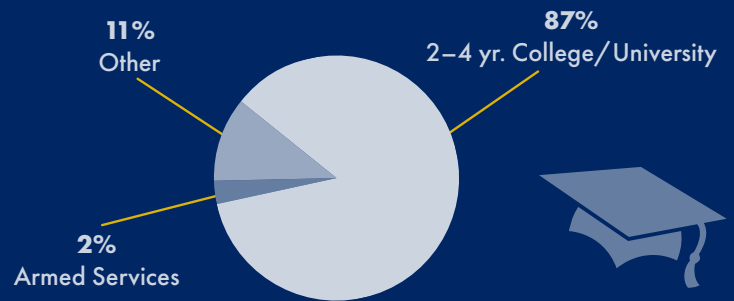
LIVING ON CAMPUS
