VCS offers 6th through 11th grade placements for international students. This school is authorized under United States federal law to enroll nonimmigrant alien students. International students applying for 6th and 7th grades are required to live with their parents. Students applying for the 8th-11th grades and who are not living with their parents may reside with a host family. Students are not allowed to enter Valley Christian Schools for the 12th grade only.
