Academic Excellence and IB Expertise

Our expert teachers guide students through a rigorous IB Diploma Program (DP), encouraging inquiry, critical thinking, and intellectual curiosity. With personalized attention in small classes, students achieve academic mastery in subjects ranging from advanced mathematics and science to language and literature in their mother tongue. Our wide range of IB DP course offerings, from World Religions to higher-level math, visual art, and music, allows students to explore their interests while preparing for the next step in their academic journey.

Community and Service

Students at Riverstone are encouraged to become changemakers and to take informed, purposeful action in their local communities through environmental stewardship, community partnerships, and advocacy efforts. Our high school students partner with organizations like The Idaho Foodbank, the Humane Society, and the Idaho Office for Refugees. Through these collaborations, they develop civic responsibility, leadership skills, and a lasting commitment to make a positive impact.

Leadership By Example

Taking on leadership roles is an expectation of our students. Students drive initiatives in the classroom, on the trails, as student ambassadors, and through our 30+ student-led clubs, including everything from Anglers Club, Beekeeping, and Dungeons & Dragons to Chemistry & Forensics.

International Understanding

With students from 40+ nations and native-speaking teachers in Spanish, Mandarin, and German, Riverstone fosters a global community. Educational trips to Italy, Costa Rica, China, and Spain, including a Grade 9 exchange, give students hands-on international experiences. This is complemented by a diverse boarding program for Grades 8-12.

Outdoor Education

Backpacking, camping, hiking, and climbing trips challenge students to carry supplies, set up camp, and cook meals, fostering self-reliance and teamwork. Navigating unfamiliar environments and unpredictable weather builds resilience and confidence, empowering them to succeed in new and challenging situations while exploring the stunning landscapes of Idaho and the surrounding region. Their journeys often culminate in Wilderness First Aid certification and the Riverstone Outdoor Leadership Certificate, preparing them for success in all areas of life.
