Testing

This year, Madeira's standardized test is optional. We accept the following test scores:

- SSAT: www.ssat.org, Madeira School code 4768
- ISEE: www.erblearn.org, Madeira School code 472 644
- **PSAT** or **SAT**: Score reports can be submitted by parents or counselors.

Students whose native language is not English must also submit a <u>TOEFL</u> score (Madeira School code **8029**) or a <u>Duolingo</u> score.

Exam registration must be completed in advance, and the score must be sent directly to **Madeira** from the testing institution.

Campus Tours & Interviews

As part of the admission application, all students are required to complete an interview. Prospective international students are welcome to visit the campus in person. Alternatively, you can schedule a Zoom interview through your **Ravenna** account or by sending an email to admissions@madeira.org.

Students from China need to be interviewed by <u>Vericant</u> first. Once the application is complete, fluent applicants will be invited for an interview with a member of **Madeira**'s admissions office.

Deadline Date

Applications and all supporting documents must be received or postmarked by January 15. Applications received after January 15 will be considered on a vacancy basis.

Requirements

- **U.S. Guardian:** All international students are required to have a guardian living in the United States who can be contacted in case of an emergency.
- **Health Insurance**: All international students are required to participate in some form of international health insurance. International students have the option to purchase insurance through Madeira.
- **I-20:** Madeira issues an I-20 after the admitted student registers and pays the registration fee. Once you have received your I-20, click here to learn more about the application process.
