





HUMAN CENTERED DESIGN


STUDENTS AT THE CENTER.

Human-centered design starts with developing empathy for the users for whom you are designing. With that knowledge, concepts are generated that meet the functional and emotion needs of the user. This all happens in Innovation Studio, a design studio environment that teaches responsible innovation and entrepreneurship and allows for deep immersion, empathy, and creativity. Working in teams and closely with faculty, students will practice the design process on projects ranging from consumer and medical products to remedies for societal issues.


BELONGING & TOGETHERNESS
