First period, it's science! Whether taking Anatomy & Physiology, Astronomy, or Botany, your morning is full of hands-on learning and collaboration with classmates.

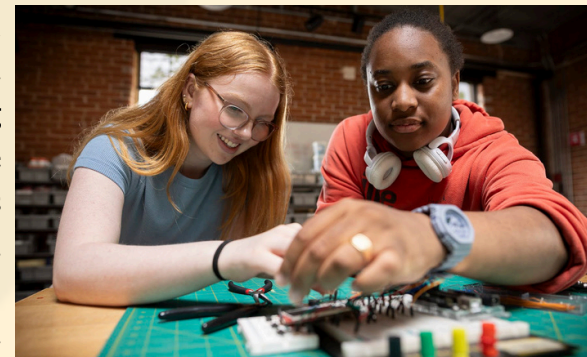


When the bell rings, you and your classmates head to Assembly in Red Hall. Led entirely by student leaders, this is the time for you to share community-wide announcements.
