



























A Day in the Life





High School Diploma

Your Pathway to Success

The High School Diploma program at CATS Academy Boston has been designed to suit each students' individual study needs and put them on the pathway to university or college success.



THE QUALIFICATION

A High School Diploma is a North American academic school qualification typically earned over the course of four years, from Grade 9 to Grade 12. It is awarded upon High School graduation.

CORE AREAS OF STUDY

To graduate from CATS Academy Boston and receive their High School Diploma, students will need to have studied the following, or the equivalent:

- 4 years of English Literature
- 4 years of Mathematics
- Up to 4 years of ESL (English as a Second Language) for non-native speakers
- 3 years of World Languages (for native speakers of English)
- 3 years of Science
- 3 years of Social Sciences/History (including one year of US History)
- 1 Year of Art and/or Technology

ELECTIVES

As well as the core areas of study, students can select elective courses from a wide range of subjects that will allow them to explore new areas of interest, or develop a subject they enjoy or want to study at university or college. There are a variety of elective courses to choose from, including Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Our teachers and counselors will guide students through the process of selecting electives to ensure they make the right choices for their university and college applications.

CHOOSE YOUR COURSES BASED ON YOUR ABILITY

College Prep

These are standard level courses suitable for most students and are needed to obtain your High School Diploma. You can expect to get 20–30 minutes of homework each night per course.

Honors

These are aimed at higher ability students. You will study in greater depth and at a faster pace. You can expect to get 30–40 minutes of homework each night per elective. You must qualify to study these courses.

Advanced Placement (AP)

These courses are aimed at high performing students, Advanced Placement courses are college-level courses that prepare students to take College Board exams which can help establish advanced placement in college courses or credit toward a college degree. On these courses, you can expect to get 60 minutes of homework each night per elective. You must qualify to study these courses.



Postgraduate Program

Our Postgraduate Program is a 1 year program for students who have graduated from their High Schools and are seeking the opportunity to strengthen their applications to gain admission to their dream university or college, while cultivating their skills and their personal potential for success in college. All students on the Postgraduate Program must take a Math and English course along with at least two additional electives.



Through our Postgraduate Program students will:

- Build their academic ability and enhance their skills in specific subject areas
- Develop their social skills, character, and independence, which is beneficial when transitioning to college life
- Work with our experienced College Counselors to select the best university and colleges for them, choose appropriate courses and extracurricular activities, build their college applications, prepare for college admittance exams
- Enjoy more independent learning and living but with support from teachers and dorm parents
- Have the opportunity to practice essential study skills such as time management, critical thinking, communication, organization, research, leadership, teamwork, and resilience
- Improve their English language skills and prepare for the TOEFL exam

CATS Extra Academic Program

CATS Extra is a focused academic program for international students entering Grades 8, 9, or 10 who have not yet met the English requirements for mainstream classes but are aspiring to earn a U.S. High School Diploma.

Designed and delivered by experienced ESL educators, the program offers a tailored curriculum in a small, supportive classroom setting to build both English fluency and academic readiness. Highly immersive and structured, CATS Extra helps students develop the skills needed to transition confidently into the full academic program at CATS Academy Boston. Upon arrival, all international students take a placement test to determine if CATS Extra is the right starting point for them.

The program typically runs for one year over two semesters, but students demonstrating rapid progress may advance to mainstream classes after just one semester by meeting the required assessment score.

In this program students will:

- Be taught by dedicated and knowledgeable ESL teachers
- Improve their overall understanding of English
- Gain confidence communicating in English
- Learn and develop subject specific vocabulary
- Proceed to mainstream classes once completed
- Receive continued ESL support in all academic course work



SCAD -The Savannah College of Art and Design was founded in 1978 to provide college degree programs not previously available in southeast Georgia and to create a specialized professional art college for students from throughout the United States and abroad.

With more than 100 degree programs in three locations, plus online programs, students at CATS Academy Boston can dually enroll and take up to 5 courses in Grades 11 and 12 and earn up to 15 credits to be eligible for a half-tuition scholarship for their chosen SCAD courses. Students are also able to transfer any earned credits to another university if they choose not to progress to SCAD.

Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA to be eligible for the scholarship and chose a minimum of 4 SCAD courses. This will give students access to a VIP admission service, giving them priority review, as well as a SCAD acceptance letter if the student is accepted as a joint enrolled student.


