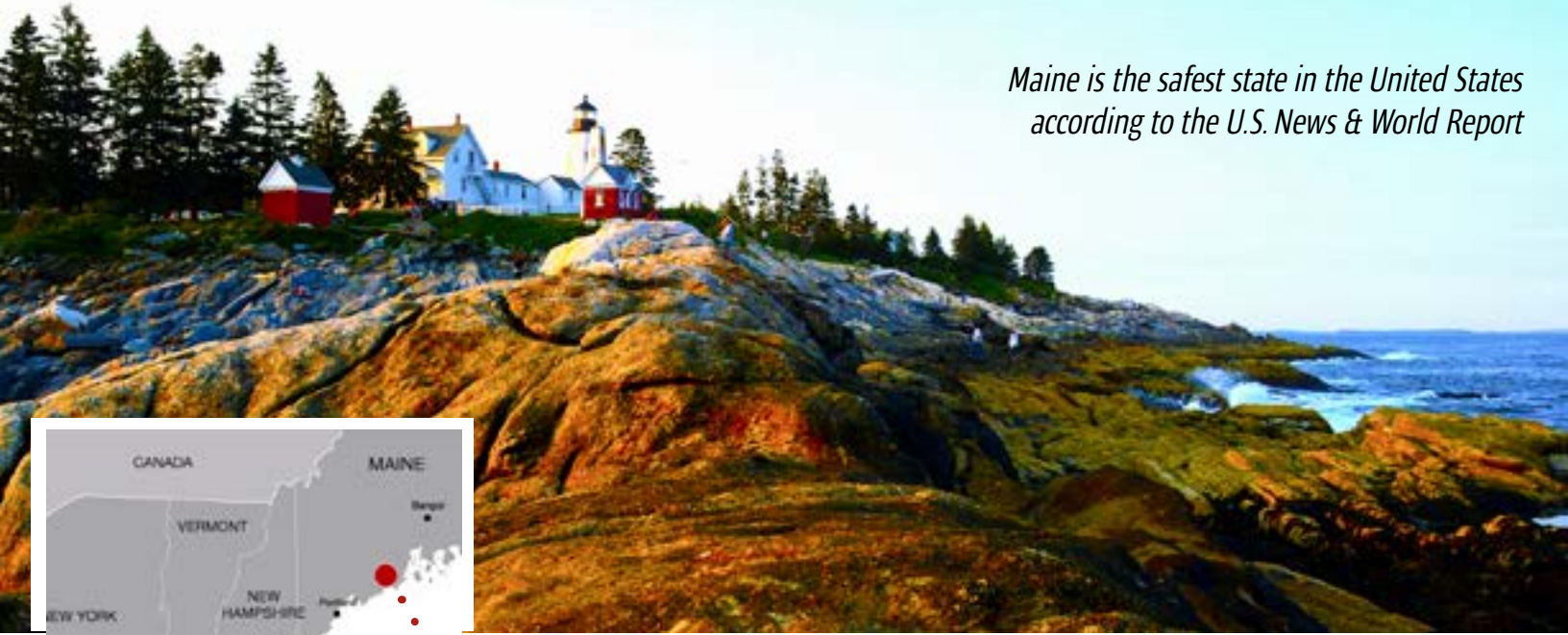

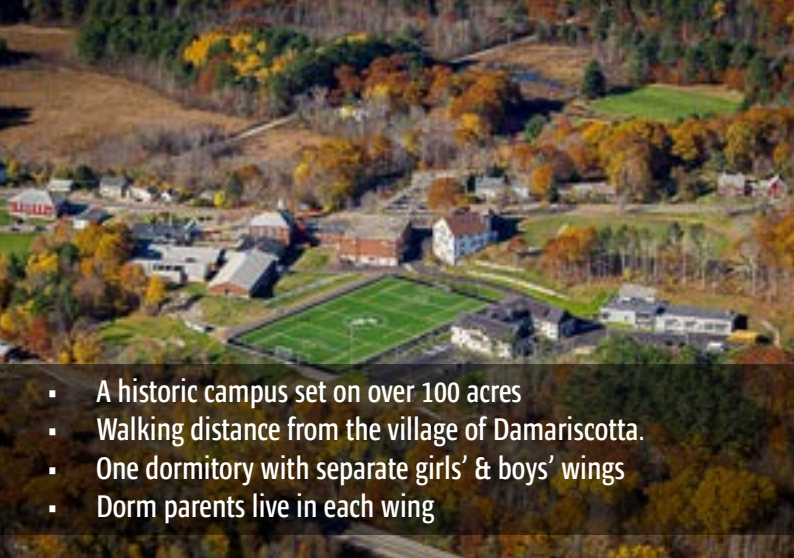

APPLY FOR ADMISSION

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis throughout the academic year as long as there is available space. The priority deadline for financial aid applications is February 15. An admission decision will be made within two weeks of an application file's completion.

Lincoln Academy encourages applications from serious academic students who are open to new challenges and experiences. To apply for admission, please submit the following:

- Completed application form (available in the online admissions portal)
- \$50 non-refundable application fee
- Two recommendation letters from teachers or administrators
- School transcripts from the past three years
- English test results: TOEFL or Duolingo
- Photocopy of passport
- Online or in-person interview
