

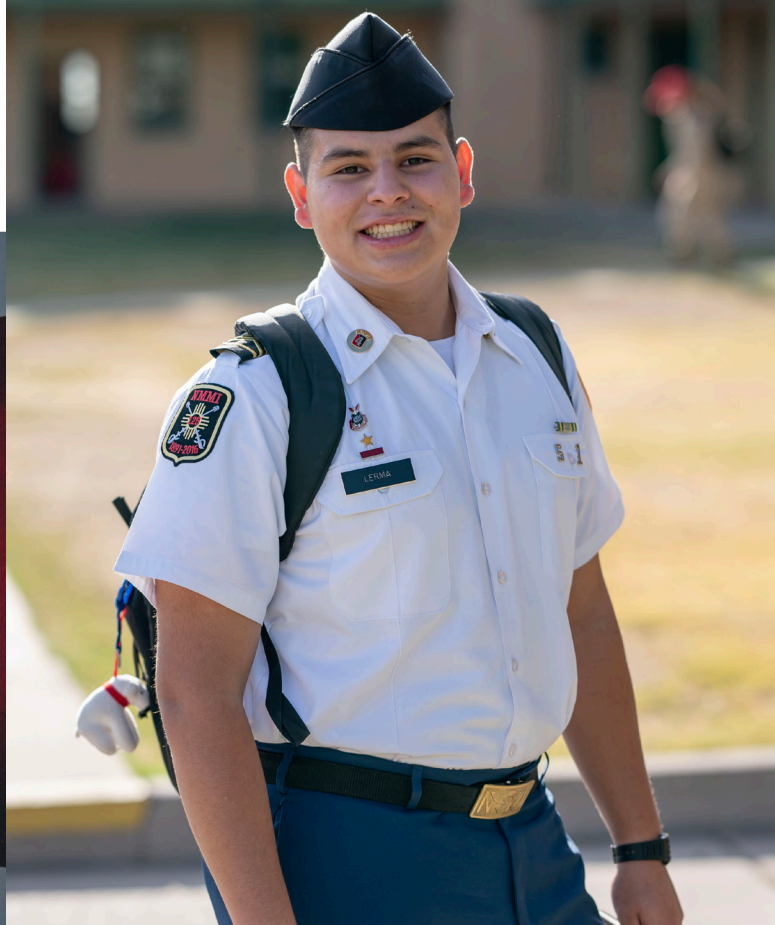

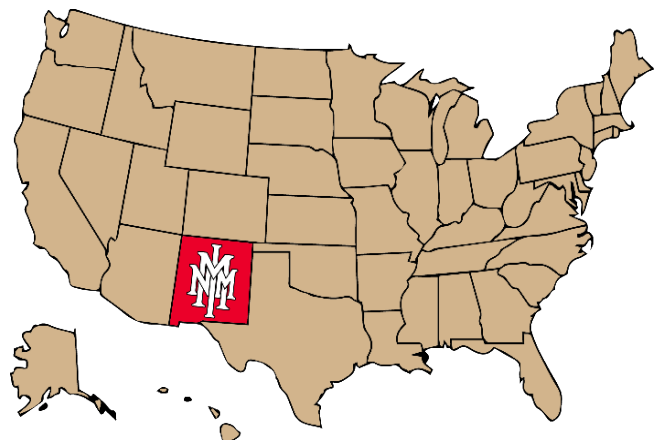

HIGH SCHOOL

NMMI's **High School** program is designed as a college preparatory course of study with a goal of developing well-rounded leaders. 100% of our NMMI high school graduates are accepted to 2-year or 4-year colleges. We offer small classroom sizes with a 12:1 student to teacher ratio. 98% of our teachers hold a Master's Degree or Doctorate. Our academic advisors work closely with our cadets to ensure they are well prepared for their desired futures and continuing education.

Scholars Program

The Scholars Program builds on the educational excellence of NMMI by encouraging talented students to gain a broad knowledge base and understanding the interaction between academic areas. To apply for admission to the Scholars program, cadets must have a projected cumulative 3.5 GPA or come highly recommended.

Dual Graduate Program

This program is designed to address the aspiration of academically exceptional high school cadets who are committed to earning their high school diploma and college degree with New Mexico Military Institute. A cadet in our Dual Graduate Program will be on a pathway toward earning an associate degree through New Mexico Military Institute upon the completion of all high school and college course work. The Dual Graduate Program has a curriculum that is broad enough to empower cadets to advance in a college environment and field of interest while continuing to fulfill their high school academic requirements.

NMMI's Dual Graduate Program earns both college and high school credit that aligns with one of the associate degrees awarded by New Mexico Military Institute. Cadets can choose to earn an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science Degree. The Dual Graduate Program offers a great option for high school cadets in terms of opportunities and financial incentives.



JUNIOR COLLEGE

NMMI's **Junior College** Program offers a comprehensive liberal arts and science curriculum with the added benefit of small class sizes for more personalized support and advising. Nationally ranked as the #1 boarding school for teachers with advanced degrees, 98% of NMMI's instructors hold a Master's Degree or Doctorate.

With a focus on the growth of the whole person, cadets study and train in a military atmosphere with many leadership opportunities. The core curriculum leads to an associate degree in liberal arts or sciences. Through specific course selection, study can parallel a bachelors degree with further education. Students work with mentors for both career and academic advising. Through NMMI's well-rounded program, cadets learn to be leaders while also building lifelong friendships in an environment that provides a vast variety of sports, music, and extracurricular activities to fit every interest.

At the post-secondary level, NMMI has partner agreements with select two- and four-year colleges and universities, which allow NMMI cadets to transfer credits across course options if programs are aligned. At present, NMMI has agreements with dozens of schools, such as:

SELF PREPS

Our Service Academy Prep Program offers a world-class structure for those who have yet to be chosen for an Academy appointment. Self Preps participate in a one- to- two year program that mirrors the academic schedules, physical fitness readiness, and leadership structure of the Academies to enhance the cadet's possibilities for an appointment.



ROTC

The Army ROTC Early Commissioning Program (ECP) is the fast-track to earning a commission while also receiving significant financial benefits to help pay for education.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Early Commissioning Program at NMMI commissions lieutenants in two years rather than the traditional four. NMMI has the right environment, the right training program, and most importantly, NMMI selects those who we believe exhibit the character and maturity to earn a commission in a compressed timeframe.

All ECP lieutenants are non-deployable until after the completion of a bachelor's degree and completion of the Basic Officer Leaders Course (BOLC).

Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP): Cadets may join either the National Guard or Army Reserve while enrolled in ROTC. SMP Cadets earn additional pay, time-in-service, and benefits. SMP is mandatory for all ROTC scholarship Cadets.

FINANCIAL BENEFITS

- All ECP Cadets receive in-state tuition rates
- NMMI ROTC Incentive (\$1000 first two semesters)
- Two year ROTC Scholarship for room and board (if eligible)
- \$200 Drill Pay one weekend per month training with National Guard or Army Reserve (Simultaneous Membership Program)

AFTER NMMI

Upon graduation from NMMI, new lieutenants carry forward the GI Bill, tuition assistance from their unit affiliation, monthly drill and annual training pay as second lieutenants, and may elect to use the Educational Assistance Program (EAP). The EAP is used to help complete bachelor's degrees and is only offered to lieutenants commissioned through the Early Commissioning Program. The EAP will cover full tuition at any university (with an ROTC program) or up to \$10,000 toward room and board.



INTERNATIONAL

International cadets at NMMI enrich the classroom environment by sharing their cultural perspectives, thereby broadening cultural horizons. This contributes to a diverse campus environment that prepares all cadets for life and careers in a global society.

International students from **over 30 countries** are part of the NMMI Corps of Cadets.

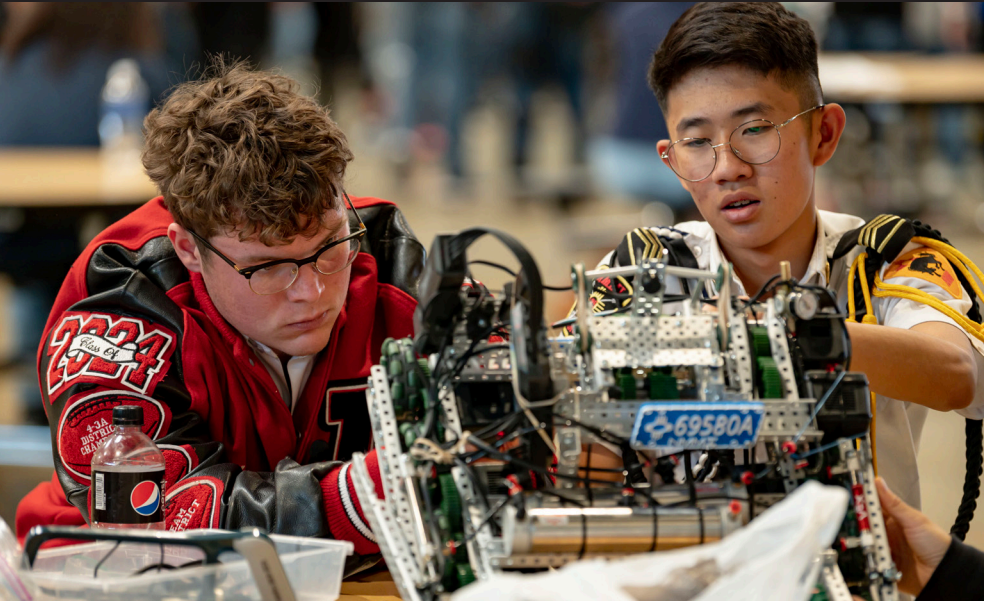

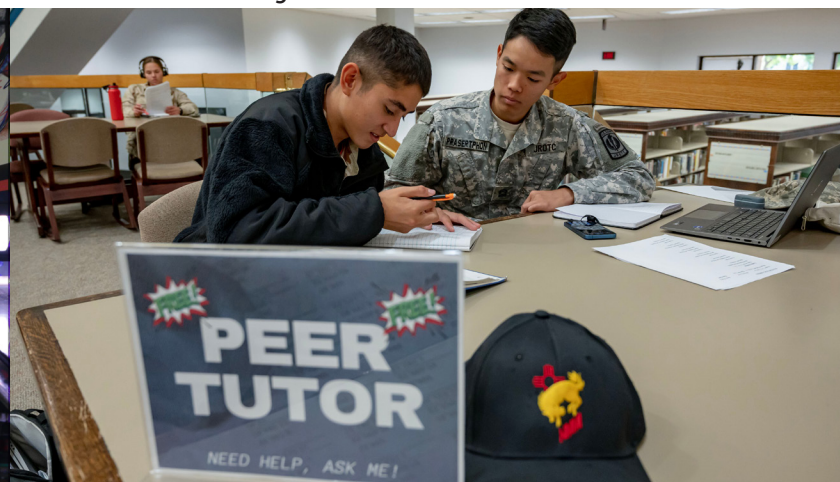
