

### College Preparation Built for the 21st Century

Kiski engages students through diverse offerings including AP courses, STEAM, ceramics, furniture building, and music, helping students discover their passions. And our dedicated college counselors work individually with each student and family to find the perfect college fit. Kiski graduates thrive at highly selective institutions.

### Personal Mentorship Beyond the Classroom

Our intentionally small community allows teachers to know every student personally. As coaches, dorm parents, and advisors, they connect with students in multiple capacities. Family-style meals four times weekly strengthen our community.

### Harkness Pedagogy: Student-Centered Teaching

Humanities teachers at Kiski deploy the Harkness philosophy of learning collaboratively through sharing ideas around student-built oval tables in a participatory environment. The teacher is a facilitator, not a lecturer – building a transformative academic atmosphere that bolsters confidence, nurtures curiosity, and fosters a love of learning.

### Independent Reading Program

Students select 6 books per semester and dedicate one daily period to reading. With no homework beyond a reading journal, Kiski fosters a love of reading among our students.
