TAKE THE FIRST STEP: Complete our inquiry form, create your admission account, and receive up-to-date information from NYA.

Admission decisions are released electronically in early March for applicants meeting the priority deadline.

Applications received after February 1 are evaluated on a rolling basis. NYA maintains a waitlist for classes at capacity.

Tuition and Fees - 2025-2026 School Year

Boarding Students: Grade 9 to Postgraduate
Tuition \$64,500



Additional Expenses:

- Books and Classroom Supplies: \$300 – \$500
- Activity Fee: \$350
- Insurance through NYA: \$2,500
- Bring Your Own Device (BYOD): Varies
