ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL)

Marvelwood's ESL program is designed to help non-native English speakers thrive—both in the classroom and in the broader boarding school experience. Through a warm, supportive approach and thoughtfully leveled instruction, students build the communication skills they need to succeed academically and socially.

Small classes at the elementary and intermediate levels allow teachers to tailor lessons to each student's strengths, challenges, and learning style. Whether students are brand new to English or building on a solid foundation, they're placed where they'll grow best.

The curriculum is dynamic and interactive, with a focus on reallife communication. Students collaborate in pairs and groups, give oral presentations, and engage with computer-based language tools. ESL classes move at a pace that's just right—fast when possible, slower when needed—always with the goal of helping students become confident, capable communicators in all aspects of school life.

Marvelwood's ESL teachers bring creativity and real-world relevance to the classroom. One day might include a debate or group discussion; the next, a hands-on cultural experience. Students have the chance to live what they're learning—whether it's carving jack-o'-lanterns in the fall, making maple syrup in a sugaring shack, softening deer hide in a longhouse, or snapping photos in front of the Statue of Liberty.

And it's not just about learning American culture—it's about sharing their own. International students enrich campus life by teaching classmates about their home countries through food, music, art, and stories. From international dinners to off-campus meals at restaurants with international cuisine, Marvelwood celebrates the diverse voices that make up its global community.
