Maui Prep's Moana Institute is a marine studies immersion program that caters to a global audience.

Students may participate in the Semester On Island program that will satisfy half-year credit requirements for most American high schools; they may participate in the Summer@Moana program, which is a less intensive 2-week program; or they may join a school group that can visit Maui and the Moana Institute at different times of the year.

The marine studies program takes full advantage of Maui's marine, coastal, and watershed resources to expose and reinforce the core environmental concept of interconnectivity.








Boarding Facility – Hale Maui

- Ocean-side facility with private beach access.
- Three-story facility providing apartment-style dorm rooms with kitchenettes, full bathrooms, ample closet storage, and outdoor/ covered lanai's with an ocean view.
- The boarding facility has security gates and cameras that provide student residents and faculty with an additional layer of protection.
- In the top-floor community room, students convene for study hours, meals, and community meetings.
