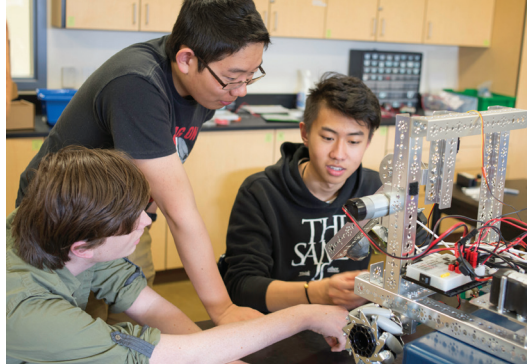




Colorado Rocky Mountain School



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PROGRAM

The International Student Program at Colorado Rocky Mountain School supports international students in their knowledge of the English language and American culture; their passions in art, music, and sports; and their acceptance at an American college or university.

International students make up approximately **15% of the student body** and come from the **12 different countries**: China, Saudi Arabia, Germany, Japan, Finland, Italy, Greece, Mexico, Spain, Hong Kong, Venezuela and Philippines.

ESOL PROGRAM

Colorado Rocky Mountain School offers two levels of ESOL – intermediate and advanced/integrated. Courses include:

- ESOL English Intermediate
- ESOL History Intermediate
- Literature and Composition (advanced/integrated)
- Foundations of Western Civilization (advanced/integrated)

Students in the advanced courses also receive daily reading and writing support from the ESOL teacher. All international students received continued academic support and instruction from the Director of the International Support Program throughout their time at CRMS, including during the college counseling process.

TRAVELING TO CRMS

Colorado Rocky Mountain School is located in Western Colorado. The nearest international airport to the school is Denver International Airport (DIA). Students can fly into Denver and connect to Aspen (ASE). (The Aspen airport is a 45-minute drive from the school.) There are direct flights into Aspen from San Francisco (SFO) and Los Angeles (LAX). We will assist families with travel plans and airport transfers. **We can also assist coordinating accommodations for school holidays when the campus is closed.**



ADMISSION PROCESS

International students must submit the following:

- CRMS Admission Application (SAO application also accepted)
- school transcript
- English teacher recommendation
- math teacher recommendation
- counselor recommendation
- SSAT and TOEFL test results.
- An interview with an admission officer

FEES

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT FEE **\$2,000**

(required for all international students)

Covers I-20 processing, additional academic support for international students, TOEFL test prep and transportation to testing sites, cultural immersion outings, and assistance with travel plans.

ESOL PROGRAM **\$3,000/YEAR**

Includes intermediate, advanced, and integrated classes.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATION **\$500**

(required for all international students)

New international students arrive to campus early for a 5-day orientation program led by the Director of the International Support Program.
