Transcripts

Include grades from the past two years as well as current grades. If you've attended more than one school, you may need to contact each school to obtain appropriate transcripts.

International Students

Submit official scores from the TOEFL or TOEFL Jr. St. Andrew's code is 3844.

Interview

Financial Aid
